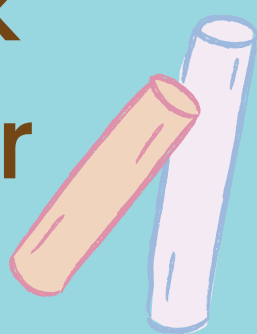
2. Read a book under a cottonwood tree



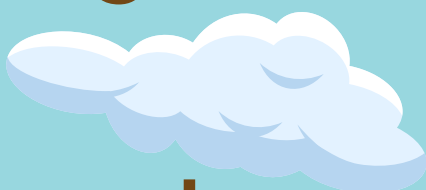
3. Count how many pollinators you can spot in the Pollinator Garden at Sand Creek Park

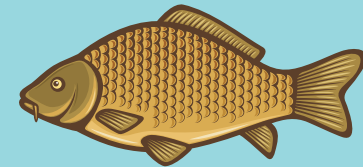
4. Create a sidewalk mural using chalk or natural materials

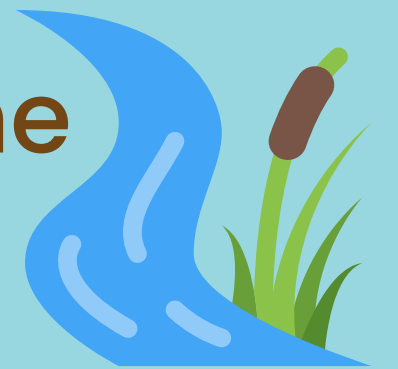
6. Catch and release a carp in the Sand Creek Park pond

13. Find all 3 creeks at the Triple Creek Trailhead



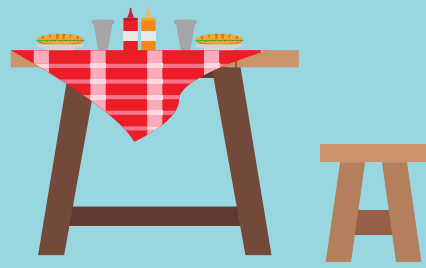

18. Count how many bugs you can find hiding under rocks along the Greenway

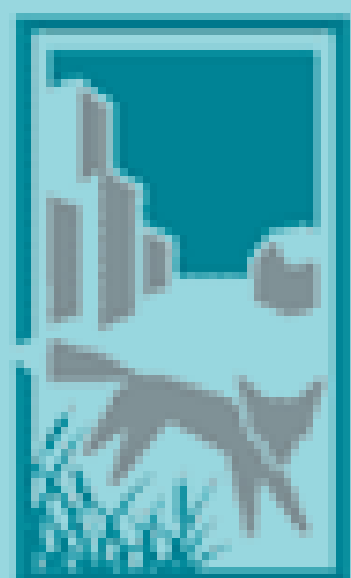


19. Look for the green painted frogs on the wall at the Dahlia Trailhead
